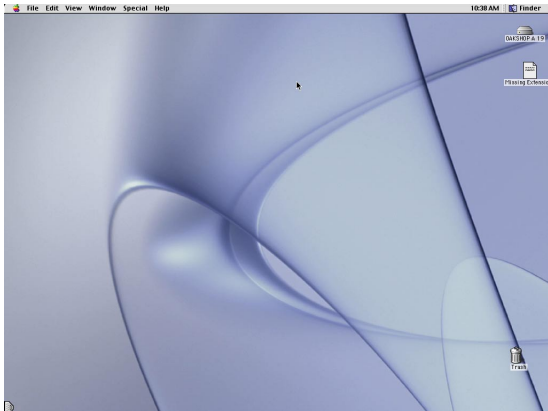


Screen Captures on the Mac



Command + Shift + 3 captures the whole screen

Using the following keyboard shortcuts, you can capture a picture of your computer's screen:

Command + Shift + 3 Captures whole screen

Command + Shift + 4 Click and drag cursor to define area of capture

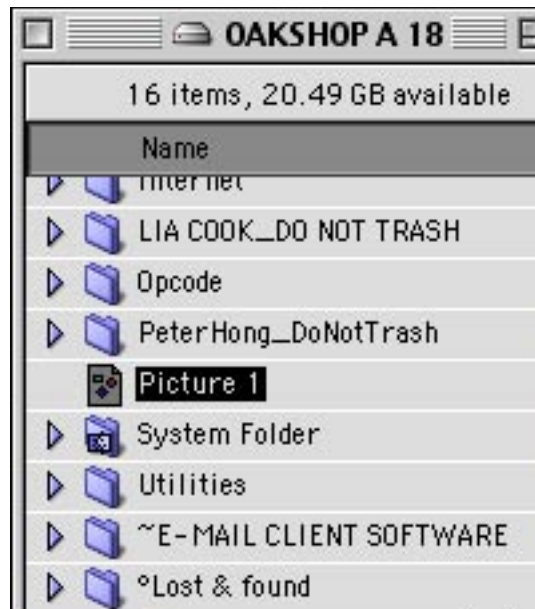
Caps Lock + Cmd + Shift + 4 Captures window

Control + any of above Captures to clipboard

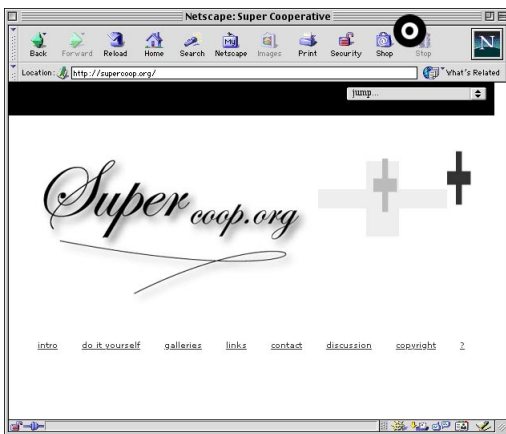
The picture of your screen is always deposited in your hard drive. The pictures are in PICT format and are named **Picture 1, Picture 2, etc.**



Command + Shift + 4
Click and drag cursor to define area of capture



Screen captures are deposited in your hard drive as files named **Picture 1, Picture 2, etc.**



Caps Lock + Command + Shift + 4
Click on any window to capture
